

PUBLIC COMMENT PORTION OF THE LIBRARY BOARD MEETING

The beginning of each Library Board Meeting is open to members of the public for up to twenty minutes to address the Board on matters that are on the agenda or regarding other issues. We ask that persons wishing to address the Board adhere to the following instructions and rules:

1. We ask that you keep your comments to less than 5 minutes in length. We will keep time.
2. You may begin after the Board President recognizes you. During the public comment portion, anyone is free to address the Board. When we get to the substantive portion of the meeting, it will take a majority vote of the Board to hear from another person.
3. Please spell your name, affiliation, and give your address.
4. State the topic you wish to address.
5. Questions and comments must be limited to library business.
6. Questions and comments must be directed to the entire Board unless the Board President permits the individual to address a specific Board member or other library official.
7. Discussion must take place in a professional manner, which displays mutual respect.
8. Profanity must not be used in any form or manner.
